## 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 About the user manual

This user manual contains descriptions for software installation for the netANALYZER PC card NANL-C500-RE and netANALYZER device NANL-B500G-RE.

The installation of the netANALYZER Scope software or driver required for the netANALYZER devices includes the following components:

- Ethernet Device Configuration Tool (only for NANLB500G),
- netANALYZER / netSCOPE Device Driver,
- netANALYZER Remote Access Window client (only for NANL B500G) and
- netANALYZER Scope software as well as the netANALYZER software.
- A suitable WinPcap driver to allow ot use a netANALYZER card or device in a network monitoring program as a recording device.

#### 1.1.1 Which software for which purpose?

- If you are a new user of netANALYZER devices, it is recommended:
  - For pure Ethernet frame recordings use Wireshark (with the included WinPcap driver), to use your netANALYZER device directly in Wireshark as recording hardware.
  - For graphical analysis, or for users with high performance requirements, it is recommended to use the extended software netANALYZER Scope.
- If you have already used the netANALYZER software and you do not require the extended scope of functions of netANALYZER Scope, the netANALYZER software is still available on the netANALYZER Scope DVD. Note that the netANALYZER software is no longer maintained and therefore should only be used to a limited extent.

  includes the analyzer driver and the analyzer firmware "Ethernet
  Analyzer".
- In order to display the recorded data contents, a network monitoring program must be installed which supports the WinPcap format, such as Wireshark.
- The WinPcap driver included on the netANLYZER Scope DVD must be installed and must not be overwritten. Otherwise, your netANALYZER device is not available as a recording device in the network monitoring program installed on your PC.

Only for analyzer device NANL-B500G-RE:

- The Remote Access Client must be installed.
- The Ethernet Device Configuration program must be installed.

The system requirements for the analysis software netANALYZER are contained in the operating instruction manual netANALYZER software.

## 4 Installation netANALZER Scope

#### 4.1 Auto boot menu

For the software installation for your netANALYZER device the netANALYZER Scope DVD contains the netANALYZER / netScope Device Driver, the netANALYZER Scope software, documentation and programming examples.

In the auto boot menu you can select:

#### **Driver and software**

If you select in the auto boot menu **Install Scope Software**, in the next dialog you can select which of the following software components you want to install:

- Ethernet Device Configuration Tool,
- License manger,
- netANALYZER / netSCOPE Device Driver,
- netANALYZER Remote Access Window client,
- WinPCAP,
- netANALYZER.

The netANALYZER Scope x 64 component is installed by default.

#### **Documentation and examples**

Via the auto boot menu you can access the storage directories with the documentation or the sample projects on the DVD.

#### 4.2 First-Time Installation

This section describes how to install the software and the driver for netANALYZER Scope when netANALYZER Scope is not already installed on your PC.

- ➢ If necessary, an Internet connection is required during installation if some of the required Windows components are not yet available.

#### Step 1: Downloading the netANALYZER Scope DVD

- Download the netANALYZER Scope DVD as a ZIP file from the website http://www.hilscher.com (under Products, directly with the information on your product) to the local hard disk of your PC.
- Unzip the zip file.

#### Step 2: Starting boot start menu and installation dialog

- Close all programs!
- ➤ Double-click in the root directory of the DVD to the file *netANALYZER* scope-2.exe, to open the autostart menu.
- The start screen of the auto boot menu is displayed with the following options:





Figure 2: Auto boot menu of the product DVD

- For each installation component, the version available on the DVD is indicated.
- For those components not yet installed on the PC **Install** appears. For the analysis software netANALYZER, you must manually select whether to install it.

For the analyzer device NANL- B500G-RE the **netANALYZER Remote Access Windows client** and the program **Ethernet Device Configuration** must be installed.




#### Important:

Make sure to install the WinPcap driver provided on the DVD, to allow to use your netANALYZER device with a network monitoring program (e. g., Wireshark).

In the installation dialog for each component (package/feature)

- Ethernet Device Configuration Tool,
- License manger,
- netANALYZER / netSCOPE Device Driver,
- netANALYZER Remote Access Window client,
- WinPCAP,
- netANALYZER (default setting "No change"),



you must specify if you want to install the component for the first time on your PC. You can choose **No change** or **Install**.

The netANALYZER Scope x 64 component is installed by default. This can not be deselected.




Figure 4: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Accepting license agreement




Figure 5: netANALYZER Scope query, 'Please close all other applications!'




Figure 6: The entry "netANALYZER\_ ..." appears only if the WinPcap driver from the netANALYZER Scope DVD is installed.




Figure 7: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - the installation of the selected components is running




Figure 8: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Installation of the selected components completed

- Download the netANALYZER Scope DVD as a ZIP file from the website http://www.hilscher.com (under Products, directly with the information on your product) to the local hard disk of your PC.
- Unzip the zip file.

#### Step 2: Starting boot start menu and installation dialog

- Close all programs!
- ➤ Double-click in the root directory of the DVD to the file *netANALYZER* scope-2.exe, to open the autostart menu.
- The start screen of the auto boot menu is displayed with the following options:




Figure 9: Auto boot menu of the product DVD




Figure 10: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Installation update






Figure 11: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Accepting license agreement




Figure 13: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Installation/update of the selected components completed




Figure 14: Auto boot menu of the product DVD




Figure 15: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Example of an existing installation that shall be removed




Figure 17: netANALYZER Scope query, 'Please close all other applications!' appears.




Figure 18: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - the uninstallation of the selected components is running




Figure 19: Installation dialog netANALYZER Scope - Uninstallation of the selected components completed
